

2022 Rotary Botanical Gardens Syrup Making in Southern Wisconsin

This program features naturalist Dave Bendlin providing an introduction to the hobby of syrup-making; a fun activity you can do outdoors during the transition from winter to spring. Besides sugar maple trees, several other trees have sap that can be cooked down into syrup; box elder, birch and walnut can also be used. In this program, you will learn how to tap trees, collect their sap and cook it down into a delicious syrup to share with family and friends.

Most of this program will take place indoors, but if weather permits, we will go outdoors to practice tapping trees and observe sap collection, so bring clothes and footwear suitable for some time outdoors.

For those interested, some basic tapping supplies will be available for purchase along with half pint jars of box elder syrup. Cash or check sales only.
